From the Pastor **JOIN THE CELEBRATION!**

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One of the great effects of the Second Vatican Council was understanding the Church as the People of God.

No longer would the role of the Faithful be to "pay and pray." No longer would a parish be "Father's church." Everybody has a role to play!

The world's bishops declared that every Catholic had the right and duty to participate in the liturgy and in the broader life of the parish. In 1965, Catholics couldn't wait to jump on the bandwagon and expand their involvement in parish life. But after so many years now, this liberation of the Faithful is often taken for granted. Many parishioners forget their great dignity that was recognized back then; now some even see involvement as a burden, something for "other people."

Today, I'm asking you to appreciate your dignity and take your place at the table! Pastors come and Pastors go, but the people remain. This is your parish! And a parish family is like our other natural family: everyone needs to pitch in and help do chores (in parish terms: ministries).

We have an urgent need now for help in these areas:

Greeters or Ushers — a critical ministry, because these folks make the first impression on visitors and parish shoppers. You "sell" CTK with a smile!

Lectors — My favorite ministry, but I'm biased: I was a Lector for almost 20 years before becoming a priest.

Cantors and/or Choir members — a bonus ministry, because those who sing pray twice!

Social Committee member — A family that doesn't get together regularly will begin to unravel. It's the same with our parish family. This is the fun ministry, as you create events for us to bond together.

Communion Ministers — Besides a need for these at our regular Masses, we have a growing need for communion distribution to the homebound and the 2 assisted living centers and 2 nursing homes we take care of. Wouldn't we want that for ourselves when we get into those situations? This ministry can be easily be done after weekend Masses, or whenever it's convenient for you. It only takes a few minutes, and it's not rocket science: we provide you with what to say, so you don't have to stress!

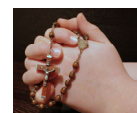
The Evening Men's Group invites both Men and Women to participate in the Bible Timeline
