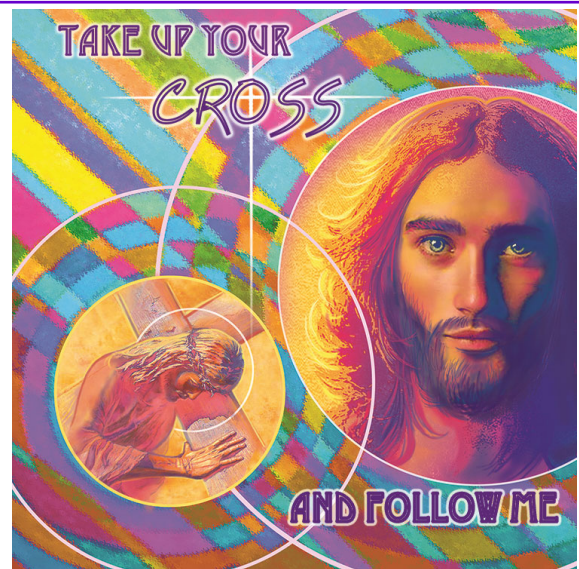

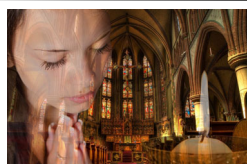


Everything You Ever Wanted to Know About Going to College
