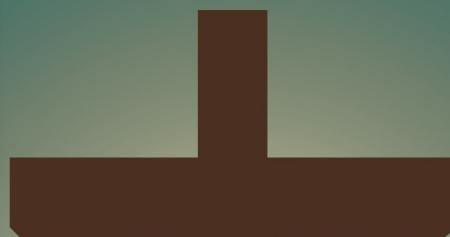

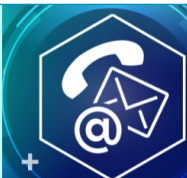

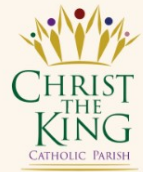

## Quarterly Financial Report



Dear Parishioners,

Here is our Quarterly Financial Report. It's a blessing to see all of our contributions being put toward the mission of this great parish that we have been given and of which we are members.

### Here's some details:

In the past year we have provided meals for the Sycamore participants in January and June, we have maintained all the normal parish expenses, we have used our insurance to replace the damaged air conditioning unit, we have wisely set aside enough funds to purchase a rectory for current and future priests, and so much more!

Also, it is important to know why the numbers are so high. The numbers for our PPP loan forgiveness are present in the past year. There is a generous contribution included for the forthcoming adoration chapel. There is another smaller but still generous donation here that will likely be used for our pathways events. Finally, our offerings and rental income came in over budget. Yet it is important to know that these numbers are not normal and will not be in this coming year's numbers.

I want you to know that the hunt for a good rectory continues. Fr. Jegan and I currently live in a diocesan house that I moved into while full time vocation director. Although, the current living arrangement has serious concerns specifically with roofing and ceiling issues. Since Fr. John Ozella purchased the old parish rectory: Congrats, Fr. John! While there is no deadline, at some point we will purchase a new home in which our priests will live.

A million thanks to you! Your continued support is what keeps our mission moving forward, keeps our community continually meeting and being a family of faith, and keeps our Lord to be praised always. Know of our love and appreciation!

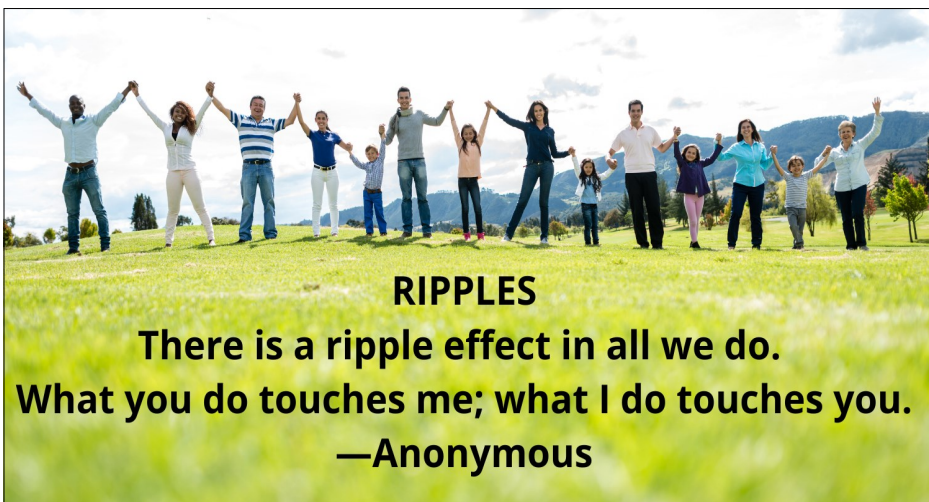
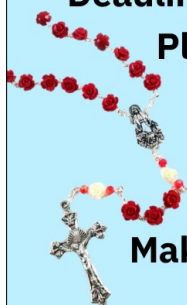

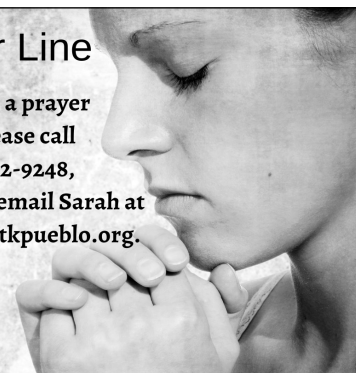
