








#### MARY'S JOURNEY BEGINS by Kathy Wolyn

The Seventh Day of Christmas is January 1st. It has nothing to do with seven swans a'swimming. Many people will use this day to make resolutions to improve themselves in the coming year. Others will spend the day watching their favorite football teams. The Catholic Church uses the first day of the new year to honor the Blessed Virgin Mary, the Mother of God.

We don't know much about Mary other than she was a virgin, young, and probably poor. Having just celebrated Christmas, we know how important Mary's decision to say yes to the angel Gabriel's announcement was. We heard how brave Mary was, to travel to a new town and then to give birth to her child in a stable. She must have still been wondering about the small miracle she held in her arms when a group of rag-tag shepherds arrived. The gospel tells us Mary kept all these things, reflecting on them in her heart. One can only wonder what she thought and reflected on at that time. Anyone who has personally held a newborn baby, especially as a new parent, knows the strange cocktail of awe, fear, and love that occurs in that moment. Considering all that had happened to her in the past nine months, those emotions must have been even more overwhelming for Mary. She was beginning more than a new year, but a new era in history. We know how her newborn son's earthly life will end, and we know that Mary will be with him at the foot of the cross.


