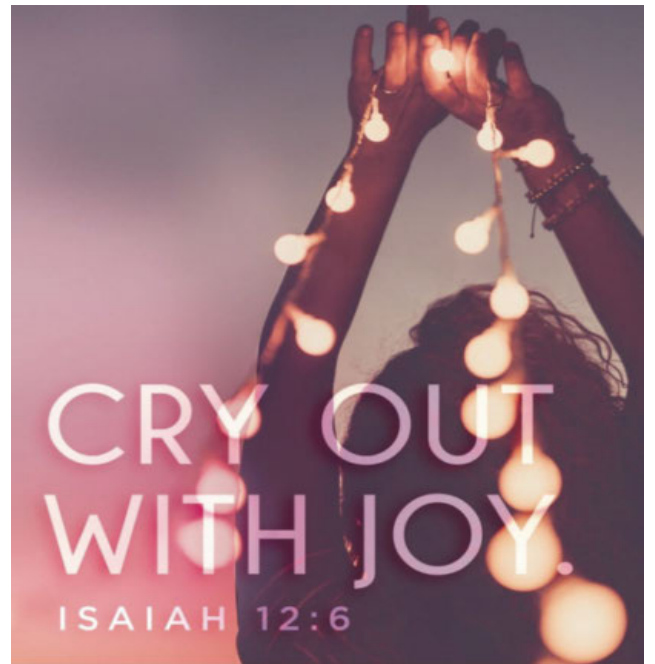


Retirement Fund for Religious
