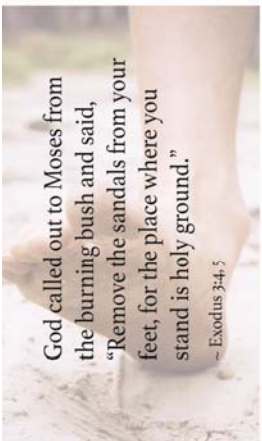

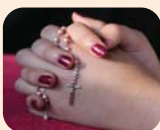

# I have called you by name you are mine.

## Isaiah 43: 1

Our central spiritual task during Lent: heartfelt repentance and renewal of the baptismal way of life. Lent is about baptism. Our ancestors in faith have passed Lent down as the Church's season to prepare to celebrate baptism at Easter, the high point of the Church's year. Taken together, Lent and the Easter season constitute the great 90 days during which Christians are literally immersed again through baptism in the central mystery of our faith: the passion, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ.

Early on our Christian ancestors developed Lent as a time to forge a people through baptism who are dedicated to Christ's saving mission in this world. This was the catechumenate process for newcomers to the faith, what our parishes know today as the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA).

By introducing these newcomers or catechumens to this life, we ourselves learn to live it more conscientiously. It is not unlike the way most of us learn to be parents. As we parents labor to pass on our deepest values to the next generation, we learn to make those values more truly our own. The world and its people await us, long for us as the ambassadors of God's great reconciling purpose. Christ, who entered into the broken heart of our world, became "sin" itself so that our very sinfulness could be transformed into the holiness of God.

This great reconciliation is God's gift and our baptismal vocation. Through sharing Christ's death our lives are to announce His resurrection to a world that hungers for such good news. - By James Schellman, CNS

## Lenten Project: Care Kit Ministry ☩ 2019

Christ the King Parish will be joining Cathedral of the Sacred Heart Parish in a Care Kit Ministry, providing personal care items for the needy and homeless in Pueblo.

We will be collecting items for personal comfort, hygiene, and first aid. These should be individual size or travel size items that are in new, unopened packaging or individually wrapped in original packaging.



After we gather these items, they will later be placed into "Care Kits" for distribution to the homeless and needy at various locations around the Pueblo area, including adult and youth clients of Posada, homeless camps, the homeless Warming Shelter, YWCA and Los Pobres.

This Lent, please be aware of those who are less fortunate and who are in dire need of assistance from Christ the King parishioners.

### Care Kit Item Suggestions

Items accepted from through April 7<sup>th</sup>, 2019  
Collection of items will take place in the Narthex

#### \*Items Most Needed Now

- \*Hand warmers – little packets that you break open, and provide warmth
- \*New socks and \*new underwear — men's & women's sizes

#### Hygiene Items

- Individual size or hotel sample size shampoo, body wash, and lotion
- Small bars of soap
- Toothbrushes, toothpaste, dental picks and floss
- Small combs
- Nail clippers
- Feminine hygiene products, pads, tampons, and wipes

#### Comfort Items

- \*\*Please No oral medications such as tablets or capsules, and \*\*No liquids or gels with alcohol (such as mouthwash or sanitizers)
- Large Band-Aids
- Blister pads or blister Band-Aids
- Small tubes of antibiotic ointment
- Foot powder
- Small packs of tissues
- Lip balm
- Cough drops and Vitamin C lozenges
- Granola bars or protein bars - individually wrapped and in original packaging, and not past the expiration date
- Zip lock sandwich and quart size bags

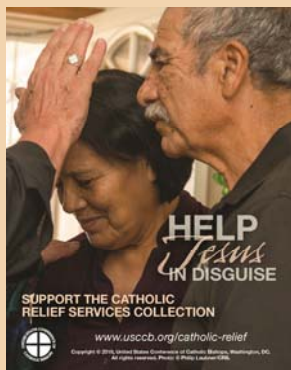

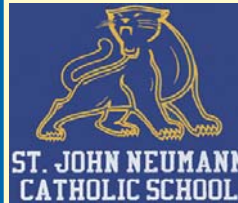

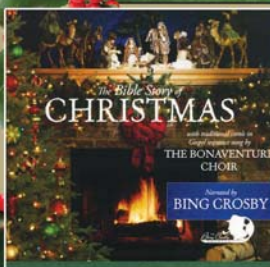
