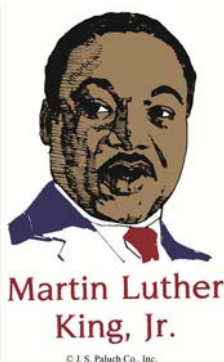

Future dates are **February 23, March 29 and April 26.**



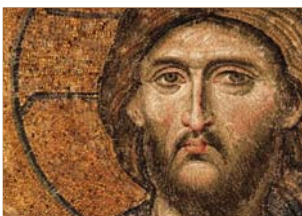
## Steubenville of the Rockies - June 19-21, 2020
