## FROM OUR PASTOR

Finally! As I write this, the pipes, lines and cords to the old defunct chiller are being disconnected. Installation of the new unit is projected to be complete by Thursday. You can look forward to a cool hall and front of church next year, most likely. We're all awaiting the post-vaccine world so churches can fully reopen again.

You may have heard Governor Polis gave a variance to the City of Pueblo's Houses of Worship so we can seat the lesser of 100 people or 50% capacity, provided 6 feet of social distancing is maintained. That's still not enough to open the church for weekend Masses.

We have 30 spots for seating in the church. Family members who live under the same roof can sit together, because that still allows for 6 feet of social distancing from the next pew of people. A family of eight could fill a pew. But if a single person comes in (and that's a lot of us!), that counts as one of the 30 spots available. So it's not enough seating yet for all of us because even our least attended weekend Masses had 160-170 parishioners participating.

So for the foreseeable future, into November, we will be holding parking lot Masses. We had about 80 cars last Sunday. If the lot gets too full we will schedule a second parking lot Mass.

We soon will have 3 First Communion Masses (more are still to be scheduled) and as of yet an undetermined amount of Confirmation Masses in the church. The 100 persons limit forces us to schedule multiple Masses so we stay legal. Headaches for Sarah, Laura and Courtney!

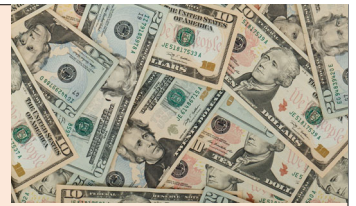

## CTK FINANCE

### SUMMARY

Thanks to the federal Payroll Protection Plan (PPP) loan (really it's a Grant), things are looking a lot rosier this month. Here's the overview:

CATEGORY	ACTUAL YTD	BUDGETED YTD
Collection Income	\$336,366	\$378,248
Total Income	\$429,321	\$484,196
Total Expenses	<u>\$429,613</u>	<u>\$492,510</u>
Net	<b>(-\$292)</b>	<b>(-\$8,314)</b>

The PPP income was a great surprise (I didn't expect any church employer would qualify for this government program) but that's only a one-time thing. Our Collection income matters more, and is sadly \$41,882 short of projection, and \$26,070 less than the previous year. What's helped is we've kept our expenses down by \$62,897. We're almost back "in the black" and would have been there sooner but for the absenteeism resulting from the coronavirus pandemic and consequent reduced Collection. By the end of June I'm hoping we can end this fiscal year "in the black" but I know we'll have that \$26,000 chiller payment to make this month and that could thwart me. June 30<sup>th</sup> is the end of our fiscal year so pray (and give) for good things!

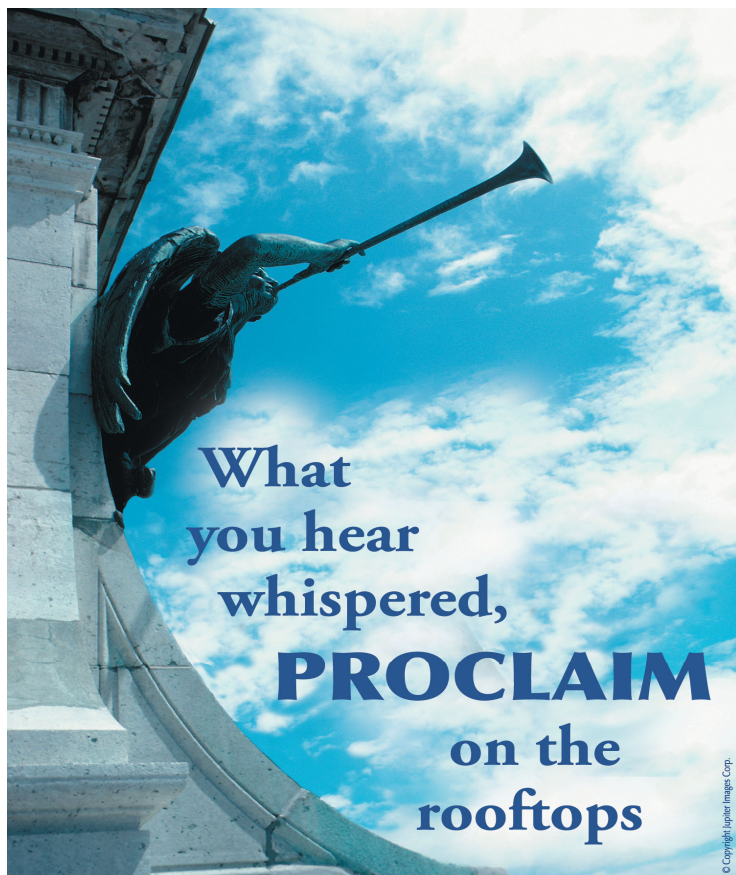

Father, during this time may your Church be a sign of hope, comfort and love to all.

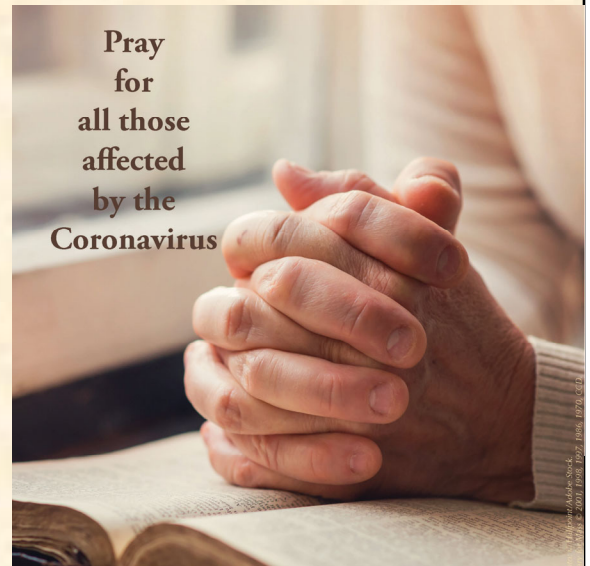

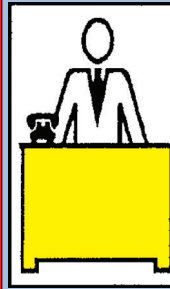

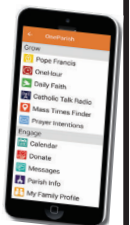
