- We're celebrating our 40th anniversary!
- ACPC was established in 1984 by a group of concerned citizens who wanted to provide alternatives to women considering abortion in the Pueblo community by offering free pregnancy tests with peer mentoring, maternity and baby supplies.
- The Walk for Life is ACPC's second largest fundraiser.
- In 2023:
 - We administered a total of **<u>381 pregnancy tests</u>**, offering clarity and support to those navigating the uncertainties of pregnancy.
 - We performed **<u>415 ultrasounds</u>**, empowering expectant parents with a visual understanding of their pregnancy journey.
 - We had the privilege of sharing the gospel with **<u>239 individuals</u>**, providing spiritual guidance and support during a pivotal moment in their lives.
 - And in a true testament to the transformative power of your support, <u>203</u> <u>patients chose life</u>, embracing the journey of parenthood with newfound strength and confidence.
