#### The Shroud of Turin

The Shroud of Turin is the most scientifically researched artifact in history. Many believe it to be the original burial cloth of Jesus Christ. Others believe it to be a fourteenth century forgery. Facilitators will summarize the historical background of the Shroud, and details of the prominent



data/evidence collected, and the conclusions of scientific experts regarding what is known and unknown from the peer-reviewed scientific data. Facilitators will create time for group reflection and discussion regarding the science of the Shroud, and its relevance, or lack thereof, to our faith in Jesus Christ and His Resurrection.

#### **HOW DO I BECOME CATHOLIC?** WHAT IF I WAS ONLY BAPTIZED?

- Have questions about Catholicsm? An unbaptized person may wish to explore becoming a Catholic. A group of adults gather to begin that process. They meet regularly with lay leaders to ask questions and receive formation. The group (known as the Catechumenate) moves in stages or steps toward Lent and the Easter Vigil when Baptism and Initiation may be celebrated.
- Someone baptized in a different Christian church may now wish to become a Catholic. A group similar to the Catechumenate receives instruction, guidance, and support towards receiving Sacraments and becoming Catholic.
- Baptized Catholics frequently discover they have yet to "become Catholic": some who missed essential religious formation may now be eager to continue the growth that all Catholics should experience. Throughout the year, the parish offers series and sessions for such


