PROCESSIONAL HYMN: GLORY IN THE CROSS oct BB 150/220

Fr/Dcn explains oil in front of altar; music starts, 1st oil processes in, silence (repeat)
(W/A) GOD OF HEALING (Campbell) (Oil of the Sick, Catechumens, Sacred Chrism)
(1 person per verse processes forward) (music continues thru incensing)

Penitential rite/Absolution spoken here

Gloria: Schutte Mass of Christ The Savior MI 894/796 (*Bells-A/S only*)

Responsorial: RS 155 OUR BLESSING CUP (all vs.) *(2nd reading here)*

Lenten Gospel Accl: (*Schutte, vs. 3*) *“I wait for the Lord; my soul waits for His Word”*

Foot Washing here: (about 10 minutes) (2 chairs, 1 person at a time) (choir sit)

LOVE ONE ANOTHER BB 409/368, v. 1 & 6 (music begins during setup)

(Following prayer, presider/deacon/servers go to sanctuary steps & kneel....

Cantor invites all to sing Pange Lingua (below))

Procession (w/incense) for Adoration of the Holy Eucharist: (W/A)

PANGE LINGUA (RS 972) verse 1 only; then change to...

STAY HERE & KEEP WATCH (RS 565)

(Sing until everyone is gathered at the Altar of Repose in Narthex....the whole procession will go down the center aisle of the church. (Lori brings up the rear.)

The choir processes immediately after Altar Servers and before the assembly (as much as possible)....make your way to the Narthex to sing Tantum Ergo)

(verses 5 & 6 (Tantum Ergo) begins as incensing of the Altar of Repose begins)
