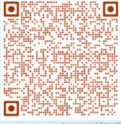

HOW DO I BECOME CATHOLIC? WHAT IF I WAS ONLY BAPTIZED?

- **Have questions about Catholicism?** An unbaptized person may wish to explore becoming a Catholic. A group of adults gather to begin that process. They meet regularly with lay leaders to ask questions and receive formation. The group (known as the Catechumenate) moves in stages or steps toward Lent and the Easter Vigil when Baptism and Initiation may be celebrated.
- **Baptized in a different Christian church?** You may now wish to explore how to become a Catholic. A group similar to the Catechumenate receives instruction, guidance, and support towards receiving Sacraments and becoming Catholic.
- **Baptized Catholics needing First Communion & Confirmation?** Some discover they have yet to "become fully initiated Catholic": you who missed essential Catholic formation may now be eager to continue the growth that all Catholics should experience. If you are still seeking First Communion, Confession and/or Confirmation, these sessions are for you!
